



Mary “Theresa” Moore (Johannes) Scholarship Fact Sheet 2019

Purpose:	This scholarship was established by Ed Moore through the North Kansas City Schools Education Foundation. It honors his wife, Theresa, a member of Winnetonka High School’s 1973 graduating class and a graduate of UMKC with a degree in mathematics three years later. Her entire 21-year career was spent at Airborne Express, where she rose to the rank of District Field Service Manager by the time she was 28. She was an extremely good judge of business talent, and many people got their start through her mentorship. She retired in 1997 to raise her family and reveled in the joy of nurturing and caring for them. Theresa will be remembered for her undefeated spirit and her enthusiasm for life. She had a rare type of cancer that usually claims a life in eighteen to thirty months. Through her efforts and those of skilled physicians, Theresa was able to prolong her life for twelve years. She died in February 2010.
Criteria:	To be eligible for this scholarship, you must meet the following criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Be a 2019 female graduate of Winnetonka High School.• Plan to pursue a post-secondary program to study math or a related field.
Supporting Documents:	Include a copy of your high school transcript and ACT scores .
Amount:	One scholarship of \$500 will be awarded annually during Winnetonka’s Senior Honors Program.
Guidelines:	Payment of the scholarship will be made directly to the institution the student will attend by the North Kansas City Schools Education Foundation.
Process:	The committee will consist of a family member and representatives from the Winnetonka Math Department.
Deadline:	Wednesday, March 27, 2019
