



## **Loy Perkins Jr. Memorial Math Scholarship North Kansas City High School**

After graduating from Macon High School, Loy received his bachelor's degree from Missouri Valley College in 1955 and then served in the U.S. Army in Korea until 1958. After returning home, Loy earned his master's degree from Northeast Missouri State University in 1961. He taught math in the North Kansas City School District for 30 years, spending the final years of his career at North Kansas City High School.

**Deadline:** Friday, March 27, 2020

**Number of Recipients:** One annually

**Scholarship Amount:** \$1,500

**Eligibility:**

- You must be a 2020 graduating senior at **North Kansas City High School**.
- You must show an aptitude for math by maintaining at least a **3.5 GPA in your math courses** while in high school.
- You must plan to pursue a post-secondary program of study at a two- or four-year institution.
- You must demonstrate a financial need.
- You must be a United States citizen or have a Student Visa.

**Supporting Documents:**

- **Official Grade Transcript**
- **Essay:** On a separate sheet, briefly explain why you enjoy math and, if applicable, why it's important to your future career. (Up to 300 words)

**Process:** Applications will be reviewed by Math Department faculty from North Kansas City High School, with the final recipient selected by members of the Perkins Family.

**Payment:** Payment of the scholarship will be made directly to the institution the recipient plans to attend by the North Kansas City Schools Education Foundation, which holds the funds for the Loy Perkins Jr. Memorial Math Scholarship.
