



Paul E. Webb Memorial Scholarship Fact Sheet 2020

This scholarship was established in memory of Paul E. Webb, a former police officer, fire chief and civil servant for the city of Avondale. He was a 1949 graduate of North Kansas City High School. Both Paul and his wife Wayne, were dedicated to serving their community. This scholarship will assist a student who plans to pursue a career in fire science, criminal justice or emergency medical services (EMS).

Deadline:

Tuesday, March 31, 2020

Number of Recipients:

One annually

Scholarship Amount:

\$500

Eligibility:

- 1) You must be a graduating senior in the class of 2020 at North Kansas City High School.
- 2) You must plan to pursue a post-secondary program of study in fire science, criminal justice or emergency medical services (EMS).
- 3) You must have maintained a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher during your high school career.

Supporting Documents:

- 1) **Official Grade Transcript:** You must have at least a **2.5 GPA** to qualify for this scholarship.
- 2) **Official Attendance Record:** This must indicate a **90% or better** attendance record or explain extenuating circumstances for your absences.
- 3) **Two Letters of Reference:** The letters may be written by teachers or others, such as an employer or religious or service group leader.
- 4) **Essay:** You must write at least a 50 word essay on why you've chosen this career path.

Process:

The selection committee will consist of members of the Webb family and one board member from the Independence 76 Fire Company.

Payment:

Payment of the scholarship will be:

- 1) For books or tuition to be made payable to the institution.
- 2) For a dedicated cause with documentation provided. This check will be made payable to a place of business, not the recipient upon approval of the committee.
- 3) The recipient must complete a minimum of one class/semester. If not completed, the funds will be returned to the Education Foundation, and the first alternate will receive the funds.
