Deadline: Friday, April 9, 2021

Number of Recipients: At least one annually

Scholarship Amount: \$500

Eligibility:

- You must be a graduating senior in the class of 2021 at Winnetonka High School.
- You must plan to pursue a post-secondary program of study at a two- or four-year institution.
- You must have maintained a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher during high school.
- You must play a sport, in school or outside of school. If the sport is outside of school, you must provide a coach's letter of recommendation.

Supporting Documents:

- **Official Grade Transcript:** You must have at least a **2.50 GPA** to qualify for this scholarship.
- **Official Attendance Record:** This must indicate a **95% or better** attendance record or explain extenuating circumstances for your absences.
- **Short Essay:** Please attach a separate page telling us about yourself and why you feel that sports, community service and high school activities are important. Be sure to include other special circumstances you wish the scholarship committee to consider when evaluating your application.
- **Community Service:** Please attach a copy of service hours in the community.

Process: The Selection Committee consists of Winnetonka Booster Club members.

Payment: The scholarship will be deposited into your student account at the college or university you plan to attend. Funds may be used for tuition, books and student fees. You must complete a minimum of one semester. If you withdraw before completing a semester, scholarship funds must be returned to the Education Foundation, which manages the AMC Graphics Scholarship. The first alternate will receive the funds instead.
