



Buddie Butterfield Hornet Golf Scholarship 2021 Fact Sheet

This scholarship was established in memory of Buddie Butterfield, a 1951 graduate of North Kansas City High School. Golf was Buddie's lifetime sport, and he became a PGA golf instructor. His passion for golf and helping people led him to found Buddie's Buddies, a nonprofit whose purpose was to enhance the personal and physical growth of participants who are mentally and physically challenged. The organization was recognized by the PGA. In addition, he began Buddie's Veterans Adaptive Golf for disabled veterans, and he hosted the annual Heartland Amputee Golf Tournament for both disabled veterans and special needs individuals.

Deadline: Tuesday, April 13, 2021

Number of Recipients: One annually

Scholarship Amount: \$500

Eligibility:

- You must be a 2021 graduating senior at North Kansas City High School.
- You must be a member of the boys or girls golf team at the high school.
- You must plan to pursue a post-secondary program of study at a two- or four-year institution or at an accredited trade school.
- You must have maintained a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher during high school.

Supporting Documents:

- **Official Grade Transcript/ACT Scores:** You must have at least a **2.5 GPA** to qualify for this scholarship. Also include your **ACT scores**.
- **Official Attendance Record:** This must indicate a **95% or better attendance record** or explain extenuating circumstances for your absences.
- **Two Letters of Reference:** One of the letters must be written by your golf coach. The other can come from a teacher, counselor, school administrator, employer or religious or service group leader.
- Your consideration will be enhanced if you **include and confirm your involvement in community service work**.

Process: The Selection Committee will consist of classmates and friends of Buddie Butterfield.

Payment: Payment of the scholarship will be made directly to the institution the recipient plans to attend by the North Kansas City Schools Education Foundation, which holds the funds for the Buddie Butterfield Hornet Golf Scholarship.
