



## **Carol L. Stockton Music Education Scholarship 2021 Fact Sheet**

This scholarship was established in memory of Carol Lynn Stockton, a former music teacher for North Kansas City Schools. It will provide a scholarship for a student who is graduating or has graduated from the district, and is pursuing a degree in music education.

**Deadline** Wednesday, April 7, 2021

**Amount** One annual \$1,500 scholarship

**Eligibility**

- You must be a graduating senior in the class of 2021 or have graduated from one of the district's four high schools within the past two years.
- You must plan to pursue or be pursuing a post-secondary program of study at a two- or four-year institution, with a major or minor in music education.
- You must have maintained a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher during your high school career OR a 3.0 GPA during college.

**Required Documents**

- Official Grade Transcript/ACT Scores: You must have at least a **3.0 high school GPA** or a **3.0 college GPA** to qualify for this scholarship. Your **ACT scores** also must be submitted.
- Official Attendance Record: This must indicate a **95% or better** high school attendance record or explain extenuating circumstances for your absences.
- One Letter of Reference: This can be from a teacher, employer or religious or service group leader.

**Process** The Selection Committee consists of former and current music teachers from North Kansas City Schools.

**Payment** The scholarship will be paid directly to the institution you plan to attend or are attending. You must complete a minimum of one semester. If you withdraw before completing one semester, funds must be returned to the Education Foundation and the first alternate will receive the funds.
