



Winnetonka Class Award 2022 Junior Application

Purpose: This scholarship was generously established by Ed Moore through the North Kansas City Schools Education Foundation. It is intended to inspire Winnetonka juniors to think about and plan for their future careers. In addition, it will give them even more opportunities to experience and practice the process of applying for college scholarships prior to their senior year of high school.

Criteria: To be eligible for this scholarship, you must meet the following criteria:

- Be a current junior at Winnetonka High School.
- Be involved in at least one community service activity.
- Maintain a GPA of 2.8 or above.
- Plan to pursue a two or four-year degree or enroll in a technical school following graduation.

Supporting Documents: Include **a copy of your high school transcript** and **two letters of reference**. One must be written by a teacher or school representative. The other must come from an outside source, such as an employer, minister or service group leader.

Amount: One scholarship of **\$500** will be awarded annually to a Winnetonka junior. The money will remain with the North Kansas City Schools Education Foundation until you have graduated from high school and been accepted at a two- or four-year institution, or technical school.

Guidelines: Payment of the scholarship will be made directly to the institution you will attend after graduating from high school.

Process: The committee will consist of a Moore family member and representatives from the community.

Deadline: Friday, April 29, 2022
