### Eligibility:

- You must be a graduating senior in the class of 2023 at Oak Park High School.
- You must have taken Vocal Music class(es) at Oak Park High School.

  - List Vocal Music Classes taken at Oak Park High School
  - **Two Letters of Recommendation:** One from an Oak Park teacher or counselor (other than Vocal Music) and one from a non-school person (not a relative)
  - **Personal Statement:** Write a statement of your goals, both educational and vocational.

**Process:** A committee of current and former Oak Park staff members select the recipient.

**Payment:** Payment of the scholarship will be made directly to the institution you plan to attend. You must complete a minimum of one semester. If you withdraw before completing one semester, you must return the scholarship to the North Kansas City Schools Education Foundation, which holds the scholarship funds, and the first alternate will receive the scholarship.
