This scholarship was established in memory of Carol Lynn Stockton, a former music teacher for North Kansas City Schools. It will provide a scholarship for a student who is graduating or has graduated from the district, and is pursuing a degree in music education.

Deadline: Friday, March 31, 2023
Number of Recipients: One annually
Amount: \$1,500

Eligibility

- You must be a graduating senior in the class of 2023 or have graduated from one of the district's four high schools within the past two years.
- Participation in at least two extracurricular activities during your high school career.
- You must plan to pursue or be pursuing a post-secondary program of study at a two- or four-year institution, with a major or minor in music education.
- You must have maintained a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher during your high school career OR a 3.0 GPA during college.

 - **One Letter of Reference:** This can be from a teacher, employer or religious or service group leader.
 - **Personal Statement:** Explain briefly why you are applying for the Carol Stockton Music Education Scholarship.

Process: The Selection Committee consists of former and current music teachers from North Kansas City Schools.

Payment: The scholarship will be paid directly to the institution you plan to attend or are attending. You must complete a minimum of one semester. If you withdraw before completing one semester, funds must be returned to the Education Foundation and the first alternate will receive the funds.
