Purpose: A graduating senior will receive a one-time scholarship of \$1,000 for excelling in visual and other fine or practical arts classes while attending Winnetonka.

Deadline: Friday, March 31, 2023
Number of Recipients: One annually
Scholarship Amount: \$1,000

Criteria:

- Student already has been accepted and plans to attend a college or university.
- Student excelled in various visual arts classes during high school.
- Student has been involved in creative classes within different departments. Classes in both the Fine Arts and the Practical Arts count.
- Student has demonstrated a drive for creative outlets/pursuits while taking multiple art classes.
- Student has demonstrated a need for financial support.

 - **Submit five examples of your creative talents** showcasing the different fine and practical art classes at Winnetonka.
 - Video or audio to demonstrate performance and photos for any visuals should be attached along with this application.
 - **Submit something that demonstrates financial need**, including a CSS profile, FAFSA EFC, or a counselor letter outlining extenuating circumstances.
