This scholarship was established in memory of Joy H. Browne, a former vocal music coordinator for North Kansas City Schools. It will provide a scholarship for a student who plans to pursue a degree in music education.

Deadline: Friday, March 31, 2022
Number of Recipients: One annually
Scholarship Amount: \$500

Eligibility:

- You must be a graduating senior in the class of 2023 at one of the four high schools within NKC Schools
- You must plan to pursue a post-secondary program of study at a two- or four-year institution.
- You must plan to major in music education.
- You must have participated in at least two activities in high school.
- You must have maintained a GPA of 2.75 or higher during high school.

Application Requirements:

- **Two Letters of Reference:** One may be written by a teacher. The other must come from another source, such as an employer or religious/service group leader.
- **Short Essay:** Explain briefly why you are applying for the Joy H. Browne Music Education Scholarship.

Process: The Selection Committee comprises current and former music teachers from NKC Schools.

Payment: Payment of the scholarship will be made directly to the institution you plan to attend. You must complete a minimum of one semester. If you withdraw before completing one semester, you must return the scholarship to the Education Foundation and the first alternate will receive the funds.
