Two graduating seniors will receive \$500 scholarships in recognition of their scholarship, citizenship and leadership, as well as their commitment to **North Kansas City High School's** core values of **Trust, Respect, Unity and Empowerment**.

This award is named in memory of Judy Hayes, a 1956 **Northtown** graduate, and funded by Ernest Mosby, Class of 1954.

Deadline: Friday, April 21, 2023
Number of Recipients: One male and one female student per year
Scholarship Amount: \$500

- You must be a graduating senior in the class of 2023 at North Kansas City High School

Process: The Selection Committee comprises current staff from North Kansas City High School

Payment: Payment of the scholarship will be made directly to the institution you plan to attend. You must complete a minimum of one semester. If you withdraw before completing one semester, you must return the scholarship to the Education Foundation and the first alternate will receive the funds.
