## Eligibility:

- You must be a graduating senior from the North Kansas City High School Class of 2023.
- You must plan to enroll in a two-year college or trade school.
- You must have maintained a cumulative GPA between 2.0 and 3.0 during your high school career.

  - **Short Essay:** Please attach a separate page explaining the career you plan to pursue and why you are applying for this scholarship. Please also share other special circumstances you wish the scholarship committee to consider when evaluating your application.

**Selection Process:** Representatives will review the applications and select the winner(s) and a first alternate.

**Payment:** The scholarship will be paid directly to the two-year college or trade school you plan to attend. Funds may be used for classes, books and student fees. You must complete a minimum of one semester. If you withdraw before then, scholarship funds must be returned to the Education Foundation so the first alternate can receive them.
