LEGACY SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Oak Park Alumni Association will award at least one \$500 scholarship to a current student whose parent is an Oak Park alum. You must graduate from Oak Park with a GPA of 3.4 or higher and actively participate in school and/or community activities. **The deadline for applications for the 2022-2023 school year is Friday, March 31, 2023.**

Deadline: Friday, March 31, 2023
Number of Recipients: At least one annually
Scholarship Amount: \$500

(Students must use their district account to access Microsoft Forms)

Eligibility:

- You must be a 2023 graduating senior from Oak Park High School
- At least one parent is an Oak Park High School alumni
- You must demonstrate active participation in school and/or community activities
- You must have maintained a cumulative GPA of 3.4 or higher during your high school career.

Application Requirements:

 - Provide the name and graduating year of the Oak Park alumni parent(s)
 - **Essay (300 word maximum):** Write an essay explaining your goals in life and how you will attain them.

Selection Process: Representatives will review the applications and select the winner(s) and a first alternate.

Payment: The scholarship will be paid directly to the program you plan to attend (a two-year college, trade school, union apprenticeship, etc.). Funds may be used for classes, tuition, books, and student fees. You must complete a minimum of one class/semester. If you withdraw before then, the scholarship funds must be returned to the Education Foundation, and the first alternate will receive the funds.
