This \$500 scholarship is given to an Oak Park senior who wishes to pursue a degree in education. It is funded through generous donations from Oak Park faculty and staff. Applications are read by Oak Park staff members, with the identity of the applicants withheld.

Deadline:	Friday, March 31, 2023
Number of Recipients:	One annually
Scholarship Amount:	\$500

Eligibility:

- You must be a 2023 graduating senior from Oak Park High School
- You must plan to pursue a degree in education
- You must have maintained a 95% attendance rate
- You must have maintained a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher during your high school career.

 - **Short Essay Answers:** Please respond to the following questions:
 - Why do you want to become a teacher?
 - What do you believe are the attributes of a great teacher?
 - What activities have you participated in that will contribute to your future teaching career?
 - Do you have a financial hardship for which financial aid is necessary?

Selection Process: Representatives will review the applications and select the winner(s), and a first alternate.

Payment: The scholarship will be paid directly to the program you plan to attend (a two-year college, trade school, union apprenticeship, etc.). Funds may be used for classes, tuition, books, and student fees. You must complete a minimum of one class/semester. If you withdraw before then, the scholarship funds must be returned to the Education Foundation, and the first alternate will receive the funds.
