



# Paul E. Webb Memorial Scholarship Fact Sheet 2023

This scholarship was established in memory of Paul E. Webb, a former police officer, fire chief and civil servant for the city of Avondale. He was a 1949 graduate of North Kansas City High School. Both Paul and his wife Wayne, were dedicated to serving their community. This scholarship will assist a student who plans to pursue a career in fire science, criminal justice or emergency medical services (EMS).

<b>Scholarship Amount:</b>	\$500

## Eligibility:

- You must be a graduating senior in the class of 2023 at North Kansas City High School.
- You must plan to pursue a post-secondary program of study in fire science, criminal justice or emergency medical services (EMS).
- You must have participated in at least two extracurricular activities during high school.
- You must have maintained a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher during your high school career.
- You must have an attendance record of at least 90% or explain extenuating circumstances.

  - **Two Letters of Reference:** The letters may be written by teachers or others, such as an employer or religious or service group leader.
  - **Essay:** You must write at least a 50 word essay explaining why you are pursuing a career in fire science, criminal justice or emergency medical services.

**Process:** The selection committee will consist of members of the Webb family and one board member from the Independence 76 Fire Company.

**Payment:** Payment of the scholarship will be made by the North Kansas City Schools Education Foundation:

- For books or tuition to be made payable to the institution.
- For a dedicated cause with documentation provided. This check will be made payable to a place of business, not the recipient upon committee approval
- The recipient must complete a minimum of one class/semester. If not completed, the funds will be returned to the Education Foundation, and the first alternate will receive the funds.
