



# 2023 R.B. DOOLIN SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

All North Kansas City School District seniors are eligible to apply for the **R.B. Doolin Scholarship**. **Two \$750 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors at the district's four high schools.** Named in honor of former **Superintendent R.B. Doolin**, these scholarships were established by the PTA Council to assist graduates attending a post-secondary institution (i.e., career and technical school and/or college) who demonstrate financial need. While an indication of probable collegiate or career and technical school success, a student's GPA is a secondary consideration in selecting scholarship winners.

**Deadline:** Friday, March 31, 2023  
**Number of Recipients:** Eight annually, two at each district high school  
**Scholarship Amount:** \$750

#### Eligibility:

- You must be a 2023 graduating senior from one of the district's four high schools
- You must plan to pursue a post-secondary program of study, including a career and/or technical school, college, or university.

  - **Letter of Recommendation:** The letter of recommendation may be from a teacher, pastor, employer, or another adult. Recommendation letters must be on letterhead and contain the original signature of the writer. Do NOT submit a recommendation letter from relatives or school counselors.
  - **Personal Letter:** Your signed personal letter should include information about your career plans, as well as interests and activities in school, church, and community organizations. Be sure to include any information about yourself that would be of interest to and help the scholarship committee with the selection process.
  - **Counselor Report:** Please use this link to request a report from your counselor. This is a requirement of the application and is due Friday, March 31 by 5:00 p.m. <https://forms.microsoft.com/r/WDMNQSPRkx>

**Payment:** The scholarship will be paid directly to the program you plan to attend (a two-year college, trade school, union apprenticeship, etc.). Funds may be used for classes, tuition, books, and student fees. You must complete a minimum of one class/semester. If you withdraw before then, the scholarship funds must be returned to the Education Foundation, and the first alternate will receive the funds.
