

## Raedele Sissom Scholarship 2023 Fact Sheet

**Purpose:** This scholarship was established by Dan Sissom through the North Kansas City Schools Education Foundation. It honors his sister, Raedele, a member of Winnetonka High School's first graduating class in 1972. Raedele lost one of her legs to bone cancer in 1965 and finally succumbed to the disease in 1975.

## **Eligibility:**

- Be a 2023 graduate of Winnetonka High School.
- Plan to pursue a post-secondary program of study at a two- or four-year institution.
- Have a physical disability or plan to pursue a career that assists people who have physical disabilities.

  - **Essay:** Please attach a separate page that describes your physical disability, how it has impacted your life and how you have worked to overcome its challenges.
  - OR attach a separate page describing your work with students with physical disabilities, how
    it has impacted your life so far, and how it will impact it in the future.
  - Be sure to include any other special circumstances, such as financial need, that the scholarship committee should consider when evaluating your application.

**Selection Process:** Representatives will review the applications and select the winner(s) and a first alternate.

**Payment:** The scholarship will be paid directly to the institution you plan to attend. Funds may be used for classes, tuition, books, and student fees. You must complete a minimum of one class/semester. If you withdraw before then, the scholarship funds must be returned to the Education Foundation, and the first alternate will receive the funds.
