Deadline: Friday, March 31, 2023
Number of Recipients: Two annually
Scholarship Amount: \$2,000

Eligibility:

- You must be a 2023 graduating senior from Oak Park High School
- You must have a GPA of at least 3.5
- You must be involved in school activities

 - **Two Letters of Recommendation:** The student is responsible for requesting a letter of recommendation from two Oak Park teachers or other staff members familiar with the student's accomplishments and character.
 - **Essay:** A one-page essay that describes moments in your life when you overcame obstacles either through school, family, or socially. Much weight is given to this essay when making our decision on scholarship recipients!
 - Please list any extenuating academic, personal, or financial circumstances you wish the Committee to consider when evaluating your application.

Selection Criteria: The application, essay and letters of recommendation of the scholarship candidates will be reviewed by the Robert L. Dameron Memorial Scholarship Selection Committee.

Scholarship Award: The winners of the scholarship will be notified of the Selection Committee's decision by late April of each year. *The recipients should accept the scholarship in writing to the committee within one week of receiving notice of the award.*
