



2023 Snake Saturday Community Service Scholarship

Purpose: This scholarship was established for North Kansas City School District students uniquely dedicated to community service and volunteerism. The success of the Snake Saturday parade and festival is achieved with the tireless help of many volunteers and organizations. This scholarship hopes to reward those students who have shown similar dedication.

Deadline: Friday, March 31, 2023
Number of Recipients: Two annually
Scholarship Amount: \$2,000

Eligibility:

- The applicant must be a graduating senior in the class of 2023 at one of the district's four high schools
- The applicant must plan to pursue a post-secondary program of study at an accredited trade program or two- or four-year institution.
- The applicant must be actively involved in community service and have shown great initiative in volunteer activities.
- The applicant must have maintained a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher AND a 90% or better attendance record during his or her high school career.

 - **Short Essay:** Please attach a separate page telling us about yourself and your history of community service and volunteerism. Be sure to include other special circumstances you wish the scholarship committee to consider when evaluating your application.

Process: The Selection Committee, which consists of Northland Festivals (the organization that runs Snake Saturday) Board members will review the applications and recommend recipients. Members of the Northland Festivals Board will have final approval. All applicants will receive letters indicating the results of the selection process. Scholarship recipients will be recognized during their Senior Honors Programs.

Payment: Payment of the scholarship will be made directly to the institution you plan to attend. You must complete a minimum of one semester. If you withdraw before completing a semester, scholarship funds must be returned to the Education Foundation and the first alternate will receive the funds.
