Objective: The Vicki Barmann Memorial SOAR Scholarship is to provide financial assistance to students who will be attending full-time at an institution of higher learning.

Eligibility: This scholarship is for students who will graduate from Staley High School in 2023. Applicants must exemplify the core values (SOAR) of Staley High School and must meet at least 4 of the 5 criteria for consideration:

- 3.5 minimum GPA
- 95% attendance rate
- Accepted to an institution of higher learning
- Involvement in school and community service
- Demonstrate Staley's core values (SOAR)
