



Woodson Moore Scholarship 2023 Fact Sheet

This memorial scholarship was established by the family, friends and former colleagues of Woodson Moore, an accounting and business teacher at North Kansas City High School. He retired in 1992 following a 32-year teaching career. The scholarship will assist a North Kansas City High School graduate who plans to pursue a degree in business or education at a college or university.

Deadline: Friday, March 31, 2023
Number of Recipients: One annually
Scholarship Amount: \$500

Eligibility:

- 1) You must be a graduating senior in the class of 2023 North Kansas City High School.
- 2) You must be interested in pursuing a degree in business or education at a college or university.
- 3) You must have maintained a cumulative **GPA of 2.5** or higher during your high school career.

- 4) Essay on a separate sheet: What activities have you participated in that will contribute to your future career as a teacher or in the world of business?

Process: The selection committee will consist of members of the Moore Family. The recipient will be recognized during the Senior Honors Program at North Kansas City High School.

Payment: Payment will be made to the college or university the recipient will attend. The recipient must complete a minimum of one year. If not completed, the funds will be returned to the North Kansas City Schools Education Foundation, which manages the scholarship, and the first alternate will receive the funds.
